## Autumn Reeser Announces Wedding Plans

Best known for her role as the conniving, power hungry Taylor Townsend in Fox's now defunct "The OC," actress Autumn Taylor recently announced plans to marry her longtime boyfriend: Actor, athlete and aspiring director Jesse Warren.

"He's my college sweetheart," the 28 year-old told *Usmagazine* at the 15th Annual Lint Roller Party in Hollywood, adding that (no surprise) she intends to be married in Autumn.

"It'll be fall for sure," she told *Us*. "I'm thinking probably San Diego so far, that's where I'm from. Maybe my parents house?"

The pair met while students at UCLA, where Warren had earned a full track scholarship and studied as a theatre major. While attending UCLA he earned a national record in the Distance Medley Relay, won NCAA nationals his senior year in 2000 and, according to his *IMDB* profile, still holds the college's 800m record (1:45.81).

Additionally, while studying theatre at UCLA he directed two short films, including 1999's "The Unattainable", establishing himself as one of the first people to incorporate theatre as a mixed medium, interacting with actors on a life-size screen while performing alone onstage.

Then 30 year-old went on to nab a lucrative Nike endorsement, running professionally for 4 years and becoming an 8-time All American as well as an Olympic Trials Finalist.

And Reeser is no slouch in the athletic department herself. A longtime performer in musical theatre, when asked about getting in shape for her wedding day Reeser told *Us*, "I'm a dancer! Modern and contemporary. It's so much fun you don't even realize what a workout it is."

With her *CW* romantic comedy series "Valentine" recently cancelled, Reeser can be seen next in the upcoming feature film comedy "Possessions."
